Zintek S.r.l declares that it is not involved, either directly or indirectly, in the following activities:

- Illegal felling or sale of wood or forest products;
- Forestry operations that violate traditions or human rights;
- Destruction of High Conservation Value Forests;
- Large-scale conversion of forests into plantations or into non-forestry use;
- Introduction of genetically modified organisms as part of forestry operations;
- Violation of any of the main conventions of the International Labour Organisation;
- Use of child labour;
- Use of any form of forced or compulsory labour;
- Labour or employment-related discrimination;
- Failure to allow freedom of association and the effective right to collective bargaining.

In line with the above, the Management has set the following goals:

1. To make FSC product groups (bearing the FSC trademark) available in line with market demands;

2. To confirm the supplier of purchased materials complies with the standards FSC–STD–40–004 and FSC– STD–50–001.

To ensure these goals are achieved, the Management has agreed to:

a) Update the Quality Management System to meet the requirements of the relevant FSC standard, and so obtain and maintain Chain of Custody certification;

b) Strengthen collaboration and improve communication with raw material (timber) suppliers;

c) Maintain a collective commitment within the business to respect the FSC principles and criteria and to achieve a Chain of Custody through employee training;



d) Publicise the FSC Chain of Custody policy;

e) Maintain its SA8000 corporate social responsibility certification (certificate no. IT19/1070).
